What is Google Classroom?

- Google Classroom is a web-based learning management system.
- When logged into Google Classroom, students can collaborate with their peers and teachers. Google Classroom offers a digital safe space for students to view class announcements, access posted course content, view posted assignments and turn in completed work. Students are able to access their work both at and away from school using Google Classroom.
- Only authorized Bulloch Academy users (students, teachers, and other designated staff members) can have access to an Bulloch Academy Google Classroom. Google users outside the BA network are not granted permission to any BA Classrooms.

Joining a Class

1 Class Code

Your child's teacher will send a code for students to type in to join.

2 Teacher Invitation

Your child's teacher will invite each student. Students will just need to click "join" on the class name.

3 Email Link

Your child's teacher will send a link to the student email address.

Parent/Guardian Summaries

Teachers will send an invitation to connect you to your child's Google Classroom. Once you connect to the classroom, choose the frequency of emails to receive. Your emails will consist of:

Class Activities

Announcements, assignments and questions recently posted by teachers

Upcoming Work

Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)

Missing Work

Work that's late at the time the email was sent
